Second Announcement

The International Conference on Radicals (ICOR – 2006) will be held in Kyiv, Ukraine, from July 30, 2006 (arrival day) till 5 August 2006 (departure day). The aim of the Conference is to discuss the recent development of theory of radicals in different algebraic systems, applications of radicals and related problems. The Conference is organized by the Kiev National Taras Shevchenko University jointly with the Institute of Mathematics of the Academy of Sciences of Ukraine.

The conference will be held in Kyiv National Taras Shevchenko University, Department of Mechanics and Mathematics. Address: Kyiv, Glushkova avenue 2, building 7.

Abstracts and Proceedings

Abstracts. A one–page abstract in English prepared in Latex should be sent to vkir@univ.kiev.ua until May 15, 2006.

Proceedings. The proceedings of ICOR–2006 will be published in a specialized mathematical journal.

Miscellaneous Information.

Currency. The Ukrainian currency is called hryvnya (UAH). The current UAH/EUR exchange rate is approximately 62/10. US dollars, EUR, and Russian rubels can easily and safely be exchanged in many exchange offices throughout the city.

Credit cards. Credit cards are not commonly used in Ukraine, however you easily can draw money from cashing mashines in banks. Some restaurants and shops accept cards, Visa or Mastercard/Eurocard are OK. Nevertheless we suggest you to have some cash, at least for your arrival day.

Time. There is 1 hour difference between the Ukrainian time and the Central European Time.

Weather. The August temperature in Kiev ranges from 23 (C) to 30 (C) degrees.

Registration fee.

The registration fee is 40 US dollars which covers publishing of Program, Abstracts, and Proceedings as well as welcome party, coffee-breaks, purchase of stationery etc. The registration fee is paid upon arrival.

Social program.

Excursions. A half of one of the days of the conference will be devoted to an excursion through Kyiv and at the end of Conference an excursion is planned to a picturesque open air museum Feofania. Walking excursions will also be organized in the downtown during the Conference.

Accommodation.

The Organizing Committee offers to choose the University guest house to those who need a cheaper accommodation (7–10 US dollars per night for a person). Please note that the number of places available at the University guest house is restricted, so that we do not guarantee the reservation there for all the participants of the conference. There is a number of hotels located not far from the University buildings (“Mir”, “Goloseevskaya”, “Druzhba”). The prices at the hotels “Mir” and “Druzhba” are about 60 US dollars for *** facilities, and at the hotel “Goloseevskaya” are about 20 US dollars for **-facilities. Further questions and requires of the participants of the conference concerning the accommodation are invited.

Travel information.

Airplane. The Kyiv airport (Boryspil) is located 30 km far of the city. Shuttle buses run between the airport and the city. Buses leave every hour and can be found in front of the terminal. There are also many taxicabs crowding near the terminal. The prices vary from 50 to 100 UAH (from 10 to 20 US dollars). If you are lost in the airport please call the Organizing Committee at **259-01-37**. You need a phone card to make a phone call. A phone card costs 9 HRN (valid for calls inside city only; 60 minutes duration). You can exchange money in bank offices at the airport. US dollars, EUR, and Russian rubels are exchanged for sure.

Train. To get the Kyiv Taras Shevchenko University please enter the metro station "Vokzal'na" located just in front of the railway station. The destination station is "Lybedska", then take please the bus No.38 to Lomonosov street (you can also take the mini-bus No. 209).
